Marvel at the majestic Royal Palace, which is the largest functioning palace in all of Europe. Stroll the gardens

of Plaza de Oriente designed by French emperor Napoleon's brother. You'll pass by the Royal Theater as the architectural beauty of the French-inspired buildings will keep your eyes darting from left to right. At the end, you'll have gained a deeper appreciation for the history of these tangled streets, as well as the many notable characters that played roles in it all.
